RULES

- Entries in all adult classes will be £1 per entry (non refundable), to be sent with the entry form provided. A maximum charge of £5.00 will be made for 5 or more entries. FREE for all children's classes. CHILDREN MAY ENTER IN ADULT CLASSES ON PAYMENT OF ADULT FEE.
- 2. In the children's classes, the exhibitors must state their age on the Entry Form. Age is taken to be the age on the date of the show.
- 3. All exhibitors must adhere to the show Rules and description of classes.
- 4. All articles must be made during the twelve months preceding, except handwork, Arts & Crafts, BUT NOT PREVIOUSLY EXHIBITED AT THE FRECKLETON SHOW.
- 5. All plants, cut flowers, pot plants, fruit and vegetables must have been grown by the exhibitor and all shall have been in his/her possession and in his/her premises for not less than one month prior to the day of the show.
- 6. Any exhibitor infringing rule 4 &/or 5 may be disqualified in all classes or prizes withheld at the discretion of the committee.
- 7. Exhibitors must provide vases, bowls or plates as specified. Any exhibit containing more or less than the correct number specified may be disqualified. Exhibitors are requested to WEIGH containers where necessary.
- 8. The committee will take all reasonable care of the exhibits, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur from any cause whatsoever or from any accident which may happen to the exhibitors or spectators, within the show hall or otherwise.
- 9. All exhibits must be brought to the Show Hall on the morning of the show and staged between 8am & 9.45am.
- All drawings, paintings and tapestries etc. will be displayed at the discretion of the organising committee. ANY ERRORS IN THE CERTIFICATES OF ENTRY CANNOT BE ALTERED IN THE SHOW HALL.
- 11. The Judges shall be empowered to withhold awards in the case of insufficient merit. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL IN ALL CASES.
- 12. Objections to any exhibits, to any certificate, prize or trophy awarded, must be made to the Secretary by 3.00pm on the day of the show with a deposit of 50p, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld. **THE DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL AND CONCLUSIVE**.
- 13. The committee shall be empowered to settle any dispute which may arise for which theses rules do not provide.
- 14. Children's prizes will be paid out in the hall from 3.30pm to 4.00pm.
- 15. No exhibit may be removed before 4.00pm, at which time all non-auctionable exhibits should be uplifted, to enable the auction to commence at 4.10pm.
